The Psalms: God's Gift Of Music

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1. Introduction

- 1.1 DVD: Psalms of David, "The Battle Scene"
- 1.2 Music
 - a. Unique gift of God to the body of believers
 - 1. Other religions do not have
 - 2. From very beginning expressed our hearts longing in songs (at Red Sea)
 - b. Music: allows us to pour out our hearts to God.

1.3 Psalms

- a. Their Nature
 - 1. rest of Bible is God speaking to us
 - 2. The Psalms are men speaking to God
 - 3. Many written by a man: "whose heart was after God"
 - 4. In reading, we see
 - we are not alone/unique: others have felt the same way.
 - how others have dealt with similar situations
 - not just "MS certified". "God Certified". Show us what is acceptable for us to say to God. Confidence that what we are saying is acceptable to God.
- b. How do we approach the Psalms?
 - 1. Clearly, different from the way we say read and study Romans 1
 - 2. They are meant to be sung!
 - 3. Suggestion:
 - Read: My situation?
 - If Yes, Meditate,
 - Expropriate: Make them our words.
 - Compose music & sing...
- c. How to preach on the Psalms?
 - 1. Clearly not like Romans 1
 - 2. We are going to look at 3 Psalms and apply this method

2. Psalm 60

- 2.1 "Selah" means stop and think, meditate, expropriate, sing...
- 2.2 The Situation
 - a. Rare: given actual situation in David's life: a battlefield defeat
 - b. Expression of his feelings: deserted by God.
 - c. Belief: He is doing what God has commanded him to do. He entered situation in obedience to God.
- 2.3 Are we in a similar situation?
 - a. Believe we have done as God wanted us to do
 - b. Results are not as expected and feel deserted by God.
 - c. I have been: Marriage...My wife and I do not see eye-to-eye e.g. place of service: Liaoning, China. only recently come to accept: perhaps God wants me to minister in Taiwan (this has provided a great relief)
- 2.4 Read on: Meditate
 - a. Cry to God
 - b. Receive God's promise of ultimate success with joy!
 - c. Doubt: God didn't help last time.
 - d. Confess need God
 - e. Promise to rely only on God (maybe last time did not rely on God but tried to do God's work relying on people: Zhang-Li mother)
 - f. Confidence that God will help! (Faith)

2.5 Expropriate

- a. forgive for doing God's work in my way.
- b. rely on God in faith to continue doing his work in his way.
- 2.6 Sing
 - a. Through our God, we shall do valiantly.

3. Psalm 61

- 3.1 The Situation
 - a. Confusion need to see the "BIG picture"
 - 1. picture of being in forest and cannot see way ahead. But if could stand on big rock could see over the trees.
 - b. Look back at past: See God's faithfulness.
 - c. Now I just want to be hugged by God (picture of a little child running to mommy or daddy: I am confused, I don't know what to do!)

3.2 Are we in a similar situation?

- a. Do we feel like this? We can't see where to go, we are confused. IF yes continue....
- b. looking at past we see God's work in our lives and take some comfort.

3.3 Read on: Meditate

- a. God Answers him: (use of he to refer to future)
 - 1. He will not die now
 - 2. God will not forsake him
- b. Respond in faith: He believes God, even though he cannot see the way.

3.4 Expropriate:

a. help me to turn to you and may I have faith like David when you speak the future.

4. Psalm 62

4.1 Observe Structure

- a. 3 Stanzas in this Psalm
- b. Repeated Chorus

4.2 Situation (Stanza 1)

- a. Know what to do in my mind
 - 1. Talk to myself: Think about God and rely on God
 - 2. I know God is reliable.
- b. But I look at my situation.
 - 1. enemies close by : so much pressure.
 - 2. who speaks truth? (leader problem) --> feel overwhelmed

4.3 Am I in a similar situation?

- a. Know the truth in my mind
- b. but my situation is different...

4.4 Meditate/Expropriate/Sing (Stanza 1)

- a. Good idea to speak to self orally and tell you hear (Oswald J Sanders, "Spiritual Depression" writes that this is one key aspect to break out of spiritual depression.
- b. Once we are with the Author then we can continue (if this is our situation it is easy)

4.5 Read on Meditate, Expropriate, Sing (Stanza 2)

- a. Talk to myself again
- b. This time look at God and meditate on him.
- c. Once we are with the Author then we can continue (this is not easy)
- 4.6 Read on Meditate , Expropriate, Sing (Stanza 3)

- a. See the real situation for man
- b. It doesn't matter if high or low.
- c. It is God who has the power
